In 2004 Wharton Media created HabitatOne, an education and outreach initiative dedicated to promotion of environmental and scientific literacy. The mission of HabitatOne is to foster environmental and scientific literacy by promoting the efforts and research of others, and by aiding in dissemination of that knowledge so that we may all gain a greater understanding of the world in which we live.

*A Seal's Life* was written, directed and produced by Drew Wharton, and narrated by Dr. Sylvia A. Earle, a National Geographic Explorer-in-Residence and world renowned ocean explorer and advocate. Filming over two years occurred at such unique locations as Año Nuevo State Reserve, California Channel Islands, Farallon Islands, San Simeon, Point Reyes National Seashore and Isla de Guadalupe, Mexico. Drew hopes that *A Seal's Life* will foster a greater appreciation and respect for the world around us which in turn will lead to further discussion and action, better conservation and more sustainable practices in our oceans and along our coastlines.



A DVD of the film will be provided to each school represented through the Munson Aquatic Conservation Exhibit Award.
